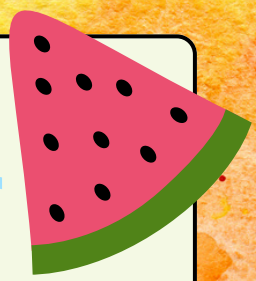

On the 26th of July, we had our residents Summer Party!

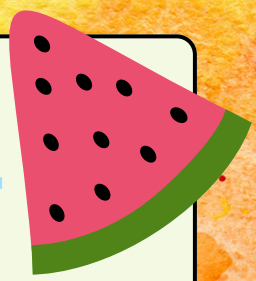
It was a wonderful success and a fantastic opportunity for residents families, friends and staff to come together for a day of celebration!
